Following you will find a quick reference guide listing the Tsukineko All Purpose Inks and Fabrico Dual Head Marker colors I chose for this project. Keep in mind these designs will look great in a variety of other colors or not colored in at all. Because of the small areas I found the Fabrico Dual Head Markers worked best and the Ink is best for the background technique.

The Angels

- Wisteria
- Poppy Red
- Emerald Green
- Baby Blue
- Maize



The Stars and Swirls

- Lemon Yellow
- Sky Mist
- Baby Blue



The Christmas Tree

- Lemon Yellow
- Kiwi on tips of branches then Emerald
- Chocolate
- As desired for ornaments



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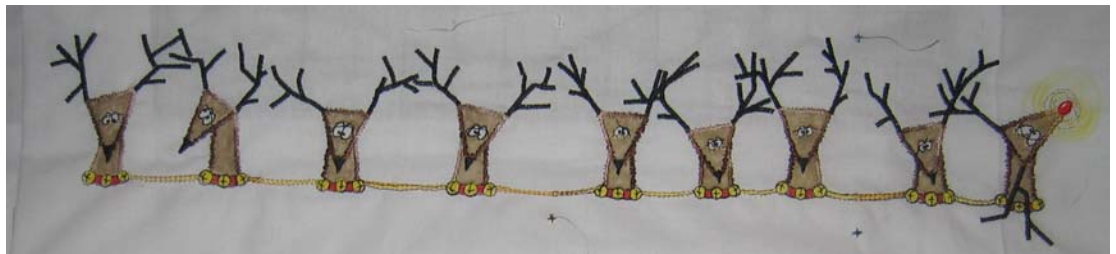
The Ornaments:

- Poppy Red
- Kiwi
- Tangerine
- Garnet
- Sand
- Ski Mist
- Baby Blue
- Ultramarine Blue
- Apricot
- Maize



The Reindeer

- Sand
- Lemon Yellow
- Poppy Red



The Holly

- Emerald or Forest on half of the Holly Leaf
- Celadon on the other half
- Poppy Red
- Bulbs as desired



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Coloring in the back ground:

1. On a flat surface mix two tablespoon of Aloe Vera Gel and 4 drops of ink.
2. Carefully dab the sponge onto the fabric, filling in the background as desired.

NOTE: Always test your color on a scrap of fabric to determine the correct shade has been achieved. Once you have mixed small amounts you will feel comfortable mixing larger amounts using the same ratios.
